Patn. P. Gerdes and R. Kelly report of receiving a signal 46, burgl at 3101 St. Charles Ave., apt. J. at about 11:40 A.M. 9-26-63.

Upon arrival at the above location, the officers met and learned from Dr. Mary Sherman, white female, age 50, of 3101 St. Charles Ave., apt. J that someunknown person(s) had apparently climbed over her front patio door; pried open a sliding screen door, which leads to her apartment, and stole the property listed in para. 13 of this report. The victim further stated that she had left her apartment Saturday 8-31-63, at about 11:00 A.M. to go on a vacation out of the United States. On Sept. 10, 1963, the victim received a letter in London telling her that a burglary had taken place in her apartment in New Orleans La. Mr. Owen Howe, white male, age 32, residing 3101 St. Charles Ave. apt. P., had noticed the victim's patio door open on 9-1-63, and notified a close friend of the victim, Dr. Carolyn Talley, of 3710 State St. Jr. and she wrote to the victim about the incident.

The victim wrote back and told Dr. Carolyn Talley to stop open the apartment, and have the door fixed and she would handle the situation when she returned to New Orleans.
